



## Remembrance 2019

To mark Remembrance this year, staff and students at St Gabriel's reflected on all those affected by war. During assemblies pupils heard about the origin of remembrance symbols such as the poppy and the marigold, and were encouraged to think about all those affected, from the civilians killed or displaced from their homes, to the women who kept Britain running during the World Wars.

During Form Time pupils created Remembrance wreaths which were filled with messages of prayer and Remembrance.

These were then put on display outside of the Resource Centre. A two minute silence was held on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November as the staff and students of St Gabriel's stood with the rest of the nation to mark this day, whilst three of our St Gabriel's pupils attended a Remembrance service at the Cenotaph in Gallipoli garden at the Fusilier Museum.

During the service our pupils stood alongside war veterans and active servicemen and women to lay a wreath on behalf of St Gabriel's to pay our respects to those who sacrificed themselves in the hope of peace.
